

Exclusive Dublin, Belfast With London



Day 01: Arrive Dublin:

Upon arrival at Dublin International Airport, complete customs and immigration formalities. Meet and greet by our local representative and transfer to your hotel. The rest of the day is free for your own. Overnight at your hotel in Dublin.

Day 02: Dublin:

After breakfast, proceed for a half-day tour of Dublin. Visit the Guinness Storehouse. It is a Guinness-themed tourist attraction in Dublin. The Storehouse covers seven floors surrounding a

glass atrium shaped in the form of a pint of Guinness. You can learn through the exhibitions spreading across the seven-storey, experience how the world-famous drink is made and then sample it for yourself at the end in the panoramic Gravity Bar. Then, proceed for Dublin Castle. This Castle has served many functions since it was built by King John of England in 1230. At that time, the castle was meant to act as a defense center against the current invaders, the Normans, and serve as the seat of the English government. Return at your hotel and the evening is free at leisure. Overnight at your hotel in Dublin.

Day 03: Dublin - Belfast:

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and proceed for Belfast. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel. Overnight at your hotel in Belfast.

Day 04: Belfast:

After breakfast, proceed for The Grand Opera House tour. Established in 1895, the Grand Opera House is Northern Ireland's premier theatre, presenting a range of drama, dance, opera, comedy, musicals, pantomime, family and West End shows. The Theatre is located in Belfast's bustling city centre and boasts the majestic Victorian main auditorium. Then visit, Belfast Castle. It is situated on the lower slopes of Cave Hill Country Park in north Belfast. It contains both parkland and mature mixed woodland and offers superb views of the city from a variety of vantage points. Later, visit Titanic Museum. This museum opened its doors in 2012 to mark the 100th anniversary of the Titanic's fateful maiden voyage. The area of Belfast Harbour that once housed the RMS Titanic has been renamed the Titanic Quarter and is dominated by the towering silver facade of the Titanic Belfast, a remarkable building fashioned from four ship-hull-shaped wings. Return and overnight at your hotel in Belfast.

Day 05: Belfast - London:

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and transfer to the airport to board your flight for London. Upon arrival, check in at your hotel and the rest of the day is free at leisure. Overnight at your hotel in London.

Day 06: London:

After breakfast, proceed for a city tour of London. The tour begins with a panoramic drive around Parliament Square, to see Westminster Abbey, where many of the Kings, Queens, Statesmen, poets and writers are buried. See Big Ben and the Houses of Parliament. Enjoy a fascinating panoramic tour seeing Trafalgar Square, Downing Street, London's Theatre District and Piccadilly Circus. Then proceed to Buckingham Palace to see the colourful ceremony of the Changing of the Guard, accompanied by a military band, a detachment of the Queen's Foot Guard march to Buckingham Palace in their bearskins and red tunics, and change with the Old Guard. The tour finishes at Trafalgar Square. Evening is free for leisure. Overnight at your hotel in London.

Day 07: London:

After breakfast, proceed for Stonehenge and Bath tour. Stonehenge is a massive circle of standing stones and earthworks in the middle of a green field in Wiltshire. It is in the middle of the most dense complex of Neolithic and Bronze Age monuments in England, including several hundred burial mounds. The surrounding circular earth bank and ditch, which constitute the earliest phase of the monument, have been dated to about 3100 BC. Then visit The city of Bath which is about 115 miles from Central London. The enormous castle which dominates Windsor dates back 900 years and remains an important royal residence to this day. Nonetheless you can still visit the recently restored state rooms and the St George Chapel, resting place of many British royals, including Henry VIII, George III and the late Queen Mother. Return and overnight at your hotel in London.

Day 08: Depart London:

After breakfast, checkout from your hotel and transfer to the airport for your flight back to India.
