

Spectacular Cambodia



Day 1:Arrival at Siem Reap :

Upon Arrival at Siem Reap airport, meet and greet with our representative and transfer to the hotel. Overnight at hotel in Siem Reap.

Day 2:Siem Reap Tour:

Breakfast at hotel. Start your sightseeing tour of Angkor area we spend a full day exploring the wondrous ancient ruins with the South Gate of Angkor Thom, famous for its series of colossal human faces carved in stone, the impressive Bayon Temple, the Royal Enclosure, Phimeanakas, the Elephant Terrace, the Terrace of the Leper King and temple of Angkor Wat. Seeing many galleries with columns, libraries, pavilions, courtyards and ponds full of water reflecting the towering temple and the jungle covered temple of Ta Prohm is an incredible sight. There are enormous fig trees and gigantic creepers which embrace themselves in the stone foundations of the structure giving the impression of man's creation being reclaimed by the powerful forces of nature. Overnight at hotel in Siem Reap.

Day 3:Siem Reap Tour :

After breakfast at hotel later transfer to airport for onward flight to Siem reap. Arrival in Siem Reap by flight , welcome and transfer to hotel. lunch on own account. Afternoon Visit Les Artisans d' Angkor, a complete visit of the Arts and crafts school will take you through the various training and production workshops of the les Artisans d' Angkor. Discover the traditional techniques used for wood sculpting, stone carving, lacquer work, polychrome and stone patina work. Overnight at hotel in Siem Reap. After breakfast, visit to Floating Village, take a ride by traditional wooden boat on Tonle Sap Lake to experience the human occupations at the edges of the lake is similarly distinctive – floating villages, towering stilted houses, huge fish traps, and an economy and way of life deeply intertwined

with the lake, the fish, the wildlife and the cycles of rising and falling waters. Afternoon, drive to the Pouk district about 15 Km in the West of Siem Reap town you visit the silk farm, a fascinating farm/workshop where you can see the entire silk creation process including growing the food for the silk worms, breeding the worms, silk extraction and refinement, traditional kit dying pattern creation and looming. Retail silk and souvenir shop. On the way back, visit the Western Baray (Baray Occidental) which provided water for the intensive cultivation of lands around Angkor. Overnight at hotel in Siem Reap

Day 4:Siem Reap-Transfer to Phnom Penh by road:

Breakfast at the hotel, transfer overland to Phnom Penh. Arrival in Phnom Penh, check in at the hotel. Overnight at hotel in Phnom Penh.

Day 5:Phnom Penh Tour:

After breakfast at the hotel proceed to Royal Palace is a royal residence now where His Majesty, the King of Cambodia, and the royal families live. It is like a small town of royal dynasties. Continue to Silver Pagoda, serves less as a functioning temple than a repository for cultural treasures such as 90 kg golden Buddha encrusted with 2086 diamonds. Later visit Tuol Sleng Museum (S-21 prison). This former school was used as a prison by Pol Pot's security forces. More than 17,000 people held at S-21 were taken to the extermination camp at Choeng Ek to be executed. Then drive to visit the "Killing Fields" of Choeng Ek (15 km south of Phnom Penh). Between 1975 and 1978 about 17,000 men, women, children and infants (including nine westerners) were detained and tortured at the S-21 prison and transported to extermination camp of Choeng Ek. Finally visit Wat Phnom Temple is one of the most important pagodas in Phnom Penh. Built in 1373 on an artificial hill by the wealthy widow Daun Chi Penh. Overnight in Phnom Penh.

Day 6:Phnom Penh Depart:

Breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Phnom Penh airport to board your departure flight.



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
