

Classic Southern Panorama



Day 01: Arrive Queenstown:

Upon arrival at Queenstown airport, complete customs and immigration formalities. Meet and greet by our local representative and transfer at your hotel. Rest of the day is at leisure. Overnight at your hotel in Queenstown.

Day 02: Queenstown :

After breakfast, proceed for Milford Sound cruise tour. Milford Sound is actually a fiord, having been carved by a glacier. It is located in the beautiful Fiordland region in the south-west of the South Island. The road to Milford is one of the most beautiful alpine drives in the world which is

approximately 16km from the head of the fiord to the open sea. The pristine Milford Sound is part of the World Heritage Fiordland National Park, in the south west of the South Island, and is famed for its pristine natural beauty and remote atmosphere. Rest of the day is at leisure. Overnight at your hotel in Queenstown.

Day 03:Queenstown :

After breakfast, proceed for Gibbston Valley wine tour. The tour gives visitors the opportunity to learn about the region's rich winemaking history. A visit to winery isn't complete without a unique wine tasting tour through New Zealand's largest wine cave. Rest of the day is at leisure. Overnight at your hotel in Queenstown.

Day 04:Queenstown - Christchurch:

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and proceed for Mount Cook tour. It's a rare opportunity to take an optional scenic flight to view Mt Cook's snow fields and glaciers. Later proceed onwards to Christchurch. Upon arrival at Christchurch, check in at your hotel. Overnight at your hotel in Christchurch.

Day 05:Christchurch:

After breakfast, proceed for whale watching tour at Kaikoura. Whales can be located in the town of Kaikoura - a scenic two and a half-hour drive north from Christchurch in New Zealand's South Island. This is New Zealand's only marine-based whale watch tour which offers visitors an exciting up-close encounter with the Giant Sperm Whale at all times of the year.

Day 06:Christchurch:

After breakfast, proceed for Hot Air Ballooning at Canterbury plains. To capture the beauty of the Canterbury Plains and the Southern Alps, hot air balloon is the best way. Watch the environment from the air, including panoramic views of the patchwork quilt-like Canterbury Plains and farmland. Ballooning is best at sunrise, when the weather is calm and the morning light is spectacular.

Day 07:Depart Christchurch:

After breakfast, checkout from your hotel and transfer to the airport for your flight back to India.
