

Eastern Europe



DAY 1:Arrive Vienna:

Arrive at Vienna International Airport. Clear your immigrations and transfer to your hotel and check in. Stay overnight at Vienna.

DAY 2:Budapest Day Trip:

After breakfast Take a picturesque drive through the enchanting Hungarian countryside to Budapest a city rich in cultural heritage. Savor the local flavors with lunch on the banks of the Danube, Europe's second longest river. Your knowledgeable guide enlightens you on the city's highlights. Glimpse the impressive Danube River on arrival and see how the elegant city is united between west bank Buda and east bank Pest. Enjoy some free time to stop for lunch, perhaps treating yourself to authentic local cuisine as you prepare for an afternoon of exploration in this magical city. DAY 3:Schönbrunn Palace + City Tour:

After breakfast, discover Vienna's most visited attractions, including the opulent masterpiece Schonbrunn Palace, former residence of the Habsburg monarchs. Explore the magnificent palace and the stunning buildings that line the city's Ringstrasse, including the State Opera House and Museum of Fine Arts. Starting from central Vienna, ride past some of the most significant and historic points in the city. Pass by numerous grand buildings along the Ringstrasse. Travel to the world-famous State Opera House one of Europe's busiest and see the stunning architecture of the Museum of Fine Arts, with its huge array of treasures from the Habsburg family. Travel to the Schonbrunn

Palace for a visit to its incredible showrooms. Once a summer residence of the Habsburg family and former home of Maria Theresa, the palace transports you back to the days of Imperial Austria. Before the end of the tour, discover the site of the world's largest and most comprehensive Gustav Klimt collection at the Belvedere Palace. Stay overnight in Vienna

DAY 4:Vienna to Ljubljana:

After breakfast checkout from hotel and transfer to the station. From the station board your train for Ljubljana. After arriving, transfer to the hotel. Check in and stay overnight at Ljubljana

DAY 5:Ljubljana City tour:

After breakfast proceed for a city tour where you will travel back in time to the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, scoping out historic sites as you learn what life was like under this decades-long communist regime. See socialist-style buildings and statues of politicians, and hear about the ways in which Slovenia has transformed into the modern city it is today. Meet up with your guide in the newer part of downtown, where you can see socialist-style skyscrapers dotted among the old Art Nouveau and Baroque architecture. Walk towards the low-slung concrete building that houses the Slovenian Gallery of Modern Art, peek into the manicured grounds of Tivoli City Park, and stroll down tree-lined streets to see government buildings like the US Embassy and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Pause before the statue of Kidrič to hear about politics in the country following World War II, and cross Republic Square to check out the modernist facade of the National Assembly Building of Slovenia. Continue on to Star Park in Congress Square, the perfect place to look up at the hilltop mediaeval castle and admire the beautiful architecture of the Slovenian Philharmonic and the University of Ljubljana. Enjoy the peace and quiet of the car-free city centre, popping into a nostalgic riverside bar for a beer or glass of wine. Walk through the Plečnik-designed Central Market, refuelling with a tasty snack before crossing the Dragon Bridge to reach a bike-factory-turned-hangout in artsy Trubarjeva Street. Wrap up your excursion in colourful and eclectic Metelkova, an old Yugoslav military base converted into an eclectic, alternative hub with a distinctly bohemian vibe. Check out the wild street art, trendy hostels, and cool museums before enjoying a final beer amid the area's dynamic energy. After the tour, return back to hotel and stay overnight in Ljubljana.

DAY 6:Ljubljana – Salzburg:

After breakfast, checkout from hotel and transfer to the station to catch a train to Salzburg. Arrive at Salzburg and transfer to your hotel. Check in at hotel. Stay overnight at Salzburg.

DAY 7:Eagles Nest, Salt Mines & Bavarian Alps:

After breakfast, embark on a combination tour that takes you to 3 fascinating and scenic locations near Salzburg: the Eagle's Nest (Kehlsteinhaus), Salt Mines, and the Bavarian Alps. Transport and admission fees are included during this visually stunning journey into Bavaria. After convenient pick-up from your hotel, visit the famous Kehlsteinhaus, also known as the Eagle's Nest, a Third Reich-era edifice situated on the summit of the rocky outcrop of Kehlstein. This scenic hideaway was presented to Adolf Hitler on his 50th birthday as a secluded place to entertain friends and dignitaries. Explore the building and take in sweeping mountain views from a height of 6,017 feet (1,833 metre). Continue your journey to the Salt Mines, where you're presented with protective miner's clothing before entering a cave where "white gold" was harvested beginning as far back as the 12th century. Explore this remarkable underground world while knowledgeable guides tell you all about the fascinating history of salt mining. You and the family can even take a fun train ride and cruise down a set of original miner's slides. Complete your adventure with a trip to the picturesque town of Berchtesgaden and King's Lake in the majestic Bavarian Alps. Enjoy free time to stroll around central Berchtesgaden, nestled at the foothills of the surrounding mountains, and admire its historic buildings and churches. Your experience ends with a relaxing drive back to central Salzburg. Stay overnight at Salzburg.

DAY 8:Salzburg – Alpbach:

After breakfast checkout from hotel and proceed for Alpbach. To go there first take a train and transfer to Brixlegg. From Brixlegg you need to take a Bus to go to Alpbach. Check in at your hotel and stay overnight at Alpbach.

DAY 9:Alpbach:

After breakfast explore Alpbach on your own. We would recommend you to do Ski Jewel Alpbachtal Wildschonau. Stay overnight in Alpbach

DAY 10:Alpbach – Prague:

After breakfast, checkout from hotel and transfer to Prague. To reach Prague, you need to reach Brixlegg by bus. From Brixlegg transfer to Prague via Woergl. Reach Prague and transfer to your hotel. Stay overnight at Prague.

DAY 11:Karlovy Vary Tour:

After breakfast proceed for Karlovy Vary Tour which is an elegant spa town, famous for its verdant hills and thermal waters and favored for its relaxed ambiance, awaits you on this pleasant trip. Stroll the charming streets with an expert guide, enjoy a delicious lunch and spend some time exploring at your own pace, too. Sitting atop twelve natural springs in the picturesque, West Bohemian countryside, Karlovy Vary, also known as Carlsbad, is among the most visited holiday towns in the region. Get to know the town's long history, which dates back to the 14th century, as you walk the leafy streets lined with graceful, grand hotels and lush parks. See the main thermal bath complex and taste its healing waters right from the spring. Before lunch, visit the Moser Glass Factory Museum to discover the beauty of Bohemian glass craft. Enjoy the afternoon at your leisure, browsing souvenir shops, eating cakes in a traditional cafe or even getting your feet wet at a bath house. Join the illustrious ranks of Karlovy Vary fans: Chopin, Beethoven, Goethe and even Peter I of Russia have enjoyed relaxing days in this enchanting place. Return and stay overnight at Prague.
