

Spain & Portugal



Day 1: Arrive at Madrid:

Upon arrival at Madrid airport, complete customs and immigration formalities. You will be met by our representative and be transferred to Hotel. Check into Hotel. Afternoon orientation walk through the capital. We will walk through the city centre, passing the Puerta del Sol (0 point of Spain), the Calle Arena, Calle Mayor and the Plaza Mayor. Evening on your own. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 2: Madrid city tour:

In the morning, buffet breakfast, followed by a tour of Madrid. As the capital of Spain, Madrid is a city of great cultural and political importance. By the end of this tour, you will have gained a complete vision of Madrid. Enjoy panoramic sightseeing of the old part of the city. We will also approach the facade of the Royal Palace: the 18th century left its neoclassical mark on the splendid Royal Palace complex, the Sabatini Gardens and Campo del Moro, located in the city centre. The church of San Francisco El Grande, the fountains of Paseo del Prado, the Toledo Bridge, the Prado Museum, and Puerta de Alcala are also good examples of this splendid style.

Day 3: Madrid to Lisbon:

Breakfast at Hotel, check out and proceed to full day excursion to Toledo. Toledo is only one hour away from Madrid, this city belongs to the region of Castilla La Mancha. It was once the capital of Spain. On arrival guided visit of the cathedral, the church of Santo Tomas (which has one of the most important paintings of El Greco) and the Synagogue of Santa la Blanca. Walking through the castilian style streets is an adventure. Transfer to Airport for your flight to Lisbon. Arrive Lisbon. Transfer to Hotel. Check into Hotel. Day free at leisure. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 4: Lisbon tour:

After breakfast, we will discover Lisbon. On the right bank of the broad Tagus river estuary, the capital of Portugal graciously reclines over rolling hills. This is a spectacular geographical location and does much to explain the cosmopolitan history of the city. Its exceptional natural light, which has long inspired writers, photographers and filmmakers, and the medieval districts bestow Lisbon with the peculiar atmosphere of a city perched somewhere between the European north and the Mediterranean south. Free afternoon for a fado show with wine tasting. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 5:Lisbon to Seville:

Breakfast at Hotel, check out and transfer to Airport for Seville. Arrive Seville. Transfer to Hotel. Check into Hotel. Day free at leisure. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 6:Seville:

In the morning, buffet breakfast followed by a regular tour of Seville. Departure from your hotel. First stop will be the cathedral, one of the world's most beautiful Gothic temples. The dimensions of this cathedral make it the third largest church in the world. After the Santa Cruz quarter, we will pass by the Reales Alcazares (Royal Fortresses), Archive of the Indies declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO, we will reach the River Guadalquivir, where we will see the Torre del Oro, of Arab origin, which dates back to the 13th century and was part of the ancient walls. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 7:Seville to Granada by train:

after breakfast at hotel proceed to the railway station to board the train to Granada. In just 3 hours, you will be in Granada, one of the nicest cities in Spain. Possibility to book an optional flamenco dance show in the caves of Sacromonte, a mountain where gypsies lived centuries ago, they show flamenco dances, always with a local guide. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 8:Granada tour:

After buffet breakfast join a regular tour for a tour of Alhambra Palace & Generalife Gardens. We will arrive at the Alhambra, built on the top of a hill. The palace complexes of the Alhambra and Generalife, beside the Albaicin, have been declared World Heritage Sites by UNESCO. The Alhambra was the residence of the Sultan when the Arabs dominated Spain and it is a beautiful collection of buildings and gardens. We will also visit the Generalife, the country residence of the Sultan, where the orchards provided the palaces with provisions, as well as being a recreational area for the nobility. The views are incredible. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 9:Granada to Barcelona:

Breakfast and proceed to the train station to take a fast train to Barcelona. Arrive Barcelona. Transfer to Hotel. Day free at leisure. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 10:Barcelona tour:

In the morning, buffet breakfast, followed by a tour of Barcelona. The variety and wealth of Barcelona's heritage provide a number of attractive routes through its various districts. This way, the traveller will get to know the most typical monuments of the city. Barcelona is a cosmopolitan Mediterranean city. We will visit the facade of the Cathedral, the facade of the Sagrada Familia: a unique creation that has become Barcelona's most universal symbol. The visit continues to the Olympic Village, the Columbus monument and then on to the Montjuic Mountain, where you will be able to see the Olympic Stadium.

Day 11:Barcelona:

After buffet breakfast and proceed to visit gaudi City with awesome architecture. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 12:Departure :

After buffet breakfast and private transfer from the hotel to the international airport. Proceed onwards to your next destination.
