Scenic Iceland



DAY 1:Arrive Reykjavik:

Arrive Reykjavik. After Clearing Immigrations and Customs and transfer to Hotel. Shopping mall normally opens at 9am and closes at 7am. Overnight at Reykjavik.

DAY 2:Reykjavik ~ Golden Circle Super Jeep & Snowmobile Tour:

Experience the breathtaking 'Pearl Tour' of Iceland. The Golden Circle tour allows visitors to get in touch with some of Iceland's most famous and exciting natural phenomena. Our first stop is at Thingvellir National Park, which is one of Iceland's most significant historical sites where Iceland's first parliament was founded in the year 930 AD. From Thingvellir we head along mountain tracks toward the world-renowned geothermal area around Geysir hot spring, the one spouting hot spring on earth after which all other spouting hot springs are named. From there we continue on to Gullfoss (the Golden waterfall) where your proximity to its edge is so close you can feel the spray of the glacial water on your face. Next we kick the action into higher gear to get even closer to Iceland's nature and go for a snowmobiling tour on Langjokull, Iceland's second largest glacier. Overnight at Reykjavik.

DAY 3:Reykjavik ~ Blue Lagoon Tour and Gulfoss with Geyser:

visit the Blue Lagoon, a unique geothermal spa situated in a lava field south of Reykjavík. Once there you have many recreational options such as walking in the Blue Lagoon's spectacular surroundings or bathing in the milky blue-green water. start by visiting Þingvellir, a geologically remarkable place where the Icelandic parliament Alþingi was founded in the year 930 AD. The site was used for Parliament gatherings up until the 20th century, and the area is renowned for its historical significance and geological wonders. We continue on to the majestic and beautiful Gullfoss glacial waterfall and onwards to the incredible spouting hot springs of Geysir and Strokkur. We travel over the mountain heath Hellisheiði back to the capital. Overnight at Reykjavík.

DAY 4:Reykjavik ~ South Coast, Waterfalls and Glacier Hike:

Travel through the south Iceland farming lands and to the black sand beaches, thundering waterfalls, powerful volcanoes and majestic glaciers on its south coast. The first stop is at Seljalandsfoss waterfall where we can walk behind this magnificent wall of water. The tour continues with an easy hike on the ancient ice of Sólheimajökull glacier with a knowledgeable and certified glacier guide. Then onwards for a leisurely stroll along the black sand beach of Reynisfjara. The beach features stacks of basalt columns that wall off surrounding cliffs scattered with caves. Offshore you will see Reynisdrangar pillars, basalt rock stacks that rise from the sea. Icelandic legend says they were trolls turned into rock by the rising sun when they came home late after a fishing trip. We round off this great sightseeing tour with a stop at the Skógafoss waterfall. On a clear day you may have a good view of famous volcanoes, Hekla and Eyjafjallajökull. When we drive under the foothills of Eyjafjallajökull you can get a glimpse of the Westman Islands, rising steeply from the ocean just a few kilometers of the coast. This tour is a great value and easy with an adventurous twist. Sights are breathtaking and where else in the world can you stand on a glacier ice, walk behind a waterfall and stroll along a volcanic black sand beach in one day.
